## WHO IS NETTING NATIONS?



**Netting Nations** is a non-profit organization with a mission to prevent malaria by distributing Long Lasting Insecticidal Nets (LLINs). LLINs cost about \$5 each, and are the most cost-effective method for preventing malaria. **Netting Nations** is made up of a diverse group of young professionals, most of whom live in the Los Angeles area.

### WHY MOSQUITO NETS?

Nets save lives. Here's why:

Most mosquito bites occur at night, between 10:00 p.m. and 4:00 a.m. while the victim sleeps. Insecticidal nets kill or repel mosquitoes on contact, sheltering the person from a potentially fatal bite. Nets provide a comfortable and safe sleeping environment. Nets relieve pain, suffering, and death.

### WHY MALARIA?

Humans are at war with malaria, and malaria is winning.

Malaria is one of the greatest public health challenges facing humans today. Malaria kills over one million people each year. Every thirty seconds a child dies from malaria. More people have died from malaria than from all wars combined. This war can and must be won.

### HOW AND WHERE ARE NETS DISTRIBUTED?

Netting Nations either distributes nets themselves, or partners with trusted organizations with boots "on the ground" in Africa. We focus on surgical strikes in areas where we can have the greatest impact, such as refugee camps, hospitals, and orphanages. So far, Netting Nations has distributed approximately 10,000 nets.
